The exhibition '**Mo.mento**' is presented by Bernard WI Sszto, aiming to explore the unconscious recognition of the passing time, question of time or more specifically, ways of experiencing time. It is the sudden capture of the frozen time when everything exists at a glimpse. What it presents can somehow be described as an actual moment and simultaneously an imaginary one. It is as if the paintings itself imparted an aura of reality to something which is an ideal, hypothetic projection, thereby confounding realities with perception of beauty and moral experiences.

Wreathed in the hustle and hustle of urban London, people seem to neglect the changing moments of nature. Under the concrete walls and boundaries of buildings, everything seems to be blocked out and everyone keeps their head down, and yet there is nature that is so close to us.

Blue Series is a series of work produced over a period of ten months based on the changing scene of the landscape within the fixed location, the changing season and weather conditions. Everything in nature is subordinated to the principle of change and changeability, whether it is formed or in the momentary process of making through times. What is seen is the paraphrase and stillness in nature.

Together with the exhibition there are studies and paintings in relation to the theme.
